Use of electrical equipment - Trailing electrical cables	Members/ Visitors - Trips or falls	All cables routed, covered with mats or secured with Hi Vis safety tape
Use of equipment – Placed at height	Members/ Visitors - Risk of falling equipment	All equipment placed on secure stand
Manual Handling –	Members/ Visitors - Trips, falls,	Use appropriate manual handling techniques
Moving of chairs and tables	sprains	Heavy items moved by more than one person or by using trolleys provided by venue
Fire	Members/ Visitors - Burns/ Smoke Inhalation/ Death	 Chairperson / Host advise all present of fire exits, fire alarm activators, assembly point and actions to be taken in the event of an emergency Fire exits are not obstructed at any time
		 Number of attendees do not exceed the limit of the venue
		 Seating layout ensures sufficient space to move freely if necessary
		Count of attendees maintained and checked at assembly point in case of evacuation
Catering – Use of kitchen	Members - Burns, Scalds, Slips, Trips and Falls	 Only members shown correct operation of kitchen facilities allowed to use kitchen equipment
		 Caution when handling hot liquids (e.g. preparation of teas & coffees)
		 Spillages cleaned up immediately, preventing slips and falls
Personal equipment	Members/ Visitors – damage/loss	 Store personal equipment and belongings securely to prevent damage as well as trips or falls to other members / visitors
		Members and visitors are responsible for their personal equipment and belongings
Medical problems	Members/ Visitors	Do not attend an activity if unwell
		Inform organiser if leaving the event
		 Inform the organiser of relevant medical issues as needed
		Contact emergency services if needed
