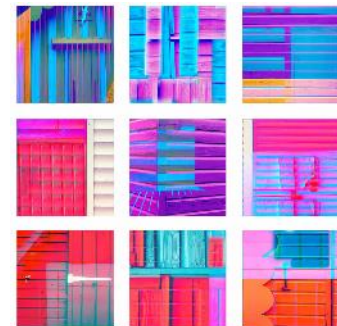

Panel Print Competition – 11th April 2024

The idea of a panel is to submit **a set of images with a common theme, link or story**. 'Gestalt' is the principle that "the whole is greater than the sum of the parts" so there needs to be a reason for displaying the images you've chosen together and they should work better together than they do apart

- Each panel is made up of at least 3 images (no maximum)
- Images making up a panel must be submitted on one board.
 - Each panel may be a single print or multiple prints mounted on a single board
 - 400mm x 500mm mount recommended but if larger, the board must fit on our club lightbox
- The panel will be judged and assessed as a whole not as individual images
